

## **ERNEST CARMON MOSER SCHOLARSHIP**

This Scholarship will be awarded to a worthy graduate of the high schools serving Wayne County and attending the University of Iowa.

All scholarship money will be paid to the scholarship winner upon presentation of proof of enrollment at the University of Iowa for the fall semester.

### **ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:**

1. Applicants must be residents of Wayne County and be graduating from one of the following schools serving Wayne County students: Lineville-Clio Community School District, Mormon Trail Community School District, Seymour Community School District, or Wayne Community School District (or districts succeeding these districts and serving Wayne County) with the intention of enrolling full-time at the University of Iowa.
2. Applicants must rank in the upper half of their high school class, and have maintained at least a 2.8 grade point average on a scale of 4.0. A signed copy of the applicant's transcript must be provided.
3. Applicants must have participated in sports, music, and/or other extracurricular activities while in high school.
4. Applicants must have been involved in some form of church and/or community organization or activity.
5. Applicants must submit a letter of application, which includes the information set forth above, as well as the following additional information:
  - why they chose the University of Iowa as the institution of higher learning;
  - the area of study they plan to pursue;
  - what led them to this career choice; and
  - a summary of any work-related experience in the field of study.

6. Applicants must supply a letter of recommendation from a school representative and a letter of recommendation from a community representative
7. Applicants must appear, if requested, for an interview with the Ernest Carmon Moser Scholarship selection committee.
8. Scholarship applications must be received by the applicant's high school guidance counselor by April 15 annually.

### **SELECTION CRITERIA:**

Applications for the Scholarship will be judged using the following criteria:

1. Community Service
2. Demonstration of Leadership
3. Personal Qualities/Strength of Character
4. Extracurricular School Activities
5. Academic and Scholastic Record
6. Work Experience
7. Financial Need
