

## **MARY PARKER SCHOLARSHIP FUND**

This Scholarship will be awarded to a student who is furthering their career in music. This may include the performance, direction, or teaching of vocal or instrumental music. All scholarship money will be presented upon proof of enrollment at a junior college, college or university for the fall semester.

### **ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:**

1. Applicants must be graduates of Seymour Community School District, (or district succeeding this district and serving Wayne County) with the intention of enrolling full-time at a junior college, college or university.
2. Applicants must rank in the upper half of their high school class, and have maintained at least a 2.8 grade point average. A signed copy of the applicant's transcript must be provided.
3. Applicants must have participated in sports, music, and/or other extracurricular activities while in high school.
4. Applicants must have been involved in some form of church and/or community organization or activity.
5. Applicants must submit a letter of application, which includes the information set forth above, as well as the following additional information:
  - the name of the college, university or junior college they plan to attend;
  - why they chose this particular institution of higher learning;
  - the area of music they plan to enter; and
  - what led them to this career choice.

6. Applicants must supply a letter of recommendation from a school representative and a letter of recommendation from a community representative.
7. Applicants must appear, if requested, for an interview with the Mary Parker Scholarship Committee.
8. Scholarship applications must be received by the high school guidance counselor by April 15 annually.

### **SELECTION CRITERIA:**

Applications for the Mary Parker Scholarship will be judged using the following criteria:

1. Community Service
2. Demonstration of Leadership
3. Personal Qualities/Strength of Character
4. Extracurricular School Activities
5. Academic and Scholastic Record
6. Financial Need
